As we welcome the new year, we kindly ask all residents to help keep our neighborhoods clean and up to HUNT community standards. Please take a moment to review the following reminders:

- **Holiday Decor:** All Christmas decorations should be taken down by January 9, 2026, to avoid violations.
- **Flowerbeds:** Please ensure flowerbeds are neat and well-maintained.
- **Pets:** Animals may not be tethered outside at any time.
- **Bulk Pickups:** Bulk items must be scheduled by Tuesday for a Thursday pickup. Items should not be placed curbside until Wednesday.
- **Leasing Requirements:** All residents must be in an active lease, either Month-to-Month or 12-Month. If you need to complete your renewal, please reach out to the Property Management Team and we'll be happy to assist you!

MAINTENANCE TIPS

As temperatures begin to drop, here are a few helpful reminders to keep your home comfortable this winter season:

- **Drip Faucets During Freezes:** When temperatures fall below freezing, let your faucets drip slightly and open cabinet doors under sinks to help prevent frozen pipes.
- **Keep Your Thermostat Set:** Maintain your thermostat between 70°F and 72°F for optimal comfort and to help prevent frozen lines.
- **Check & Change Filters:** Air filters should be changed every 30 days to keep your heating system running efficiently. Fresh filters can also help improve indoor air quality.
- **Avoid Space Heater Overload:** If you use a space heater, plug it directly into the wall (not a power strip) and keep it away from curtains, bedding, and furniture. Always turn it off before leaving the room or going to bed.

To qualify, both residents must be in good standing and complete a full lease term. (Move-overs and families already assigned to a home are not eligible.)


